EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROTOCOL

Evacuation:

In the event of a life-threatening situation (e.g. fire) we have staff that will act immediately to ensure all public are evacuated safely. Each member of the staff has been allocated a role during such an emergency and we are all able to keep in contact with one another using mobile phones.

The park is divided into 2 main areas (refer to map), of which each have 1 to 2 safety gathering points:

- The Café/Picnic area: Gazebo
- The Free range area: Along the driveway (Turf farm side)

GROUPS ARE TO GO TO THE SAFETY AREA THEY ARE CLOSEST TO

Staff will alert the public over the sound system and/or by approach, of the danger and remind people of the gathering points.

- There will be a staff member for each of the gathering points who will then escort the public out of the grounds.
- Whilst this is happening one of the staff will have contacted the correct authorities and/or staff members.
- Once everyone is together at least one staff member will remain with the group to carry out head counts and keep the crowd calm.
- Other staff members will return to the park grounds to make sure no one is left out there.
- Once everyone is accounted for, the park will be secured so that no one unauthorised can re-enter.
- The public will be advised and/or assisted in regards to returning home/to school/to work etc.
